CERTIFICATE IN MIDWIFERY ASSISTANT (CMA)

DURATION: 2 YEARS

DIPLOMA IN NURSING MIDWIFERY TECHNICIAN (NMT)

Develops competent nursing and midwifery technicians to deliver comprehensive care across the lifespan in hospitals and community health settings.

DURATION: 3 YEARS



03

DIPLOMA IN COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING MIDWIFERY TECHNICIAN (CHNMT)

Trains students to provide promotive, preventive and curative care to individuals, families and communities with emphasis on primary health care.

DURATION: 3 YEARS

PROGRAMME ENTRY REQUIREMENTS



CMA

- Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) with passes in English, Chichewa and any 3 other subjects.
- Minimum age: 15 years.



NMT

- MSCE with passes in English, Mathematics, Biology and any 2 other subjects.
- CMA/CHAM qualification or equivalent is an added advantage.



CHNMT

- MSCE with passes in English, Mathematics, Biology and any 2 other subjects.
- Interest in community health and rural service.

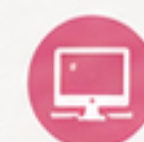
